Venture Out

I will build....

Students are able to choose which activities they want to complete over a two-week period. You/they must complete a minimum of four tasks from each area. Please complete all specialist activities

Maths....

Create some 'Hero Maths' word problems to post on the page. Eg. If a nurse saves 7 people per day, how many people would be saved in the week by that nurse? How many people would be saved if there were 10 nurses?

Place value with cards. Write Thousands, Hundreds, Tens and Ones on a piece of paper. Draw 4 cards from your pack and put one under each place value column. Now say the number! Start with 3 digits and then expand to all four!

Ask an adult for a receipt (supermarket). Create some maths problems for the items. Eg. add a selection of items together, subtract some items off the total, calculate how much you'd spend if you did this shop 3 times, etc.
