Board games, card games (don't forget Pokemon and Magic), dice games, outside games (if you can), video games, puzzles, word games and more.</p>

<p>Venture Out I will build....</p> <p>Students are able to choose which activities they want to complete over a two-week period. You/they must complete a minimum of two tasks from each area.</p>	<p>Maths....</p>	<p>Word problems - Read, understand and create a strategy to solve these tricky maths word problems! A PDF with questions will be posted on the Moa Hub Facebook page along with a video of strategies!</p>	<p>Dice roll - statistics You will need 2 dice for this activity! If you roll the two dice, what are all the possible outcomes that you can think of (e.g: 1+1, 3+6, 2+4)? What are the totals that the 2 dice make? What are the most common totals of the 2 dice? How do you know? Roll the 2 dice 10, 20...50 times and record the totals - do they match what you found before?</p>	<p>Measuring rooms Measure at least 3 rooms or spaces in your house - the length of the room and the width - use tape measure, ruler or steps to measure! Multiply the length of each room by the width to find the area of each room - compare the rooms. Which is larger/smaller - how much bigger are the rooms? A video will be posted on the Moa Hub Facebook page on Thursday.</p>
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	Literacy....	Reading - Comprehension Read the text 'Mario Kart 8 Review' and answer the questions! A PDF with the text and questions will be posted on the Moa Hub Facebook page. A supporting video will be posted on Thursday.	Writing - review a game Choose one of the games that you have played this week, or your favourite game. Write a review about it, containing best features, worst features, your opinion on how good it is and who might like this game. A supporting video will be posted on the Moa Hub Facebook page on Friday.	Spelling - continue with learning spelling words We all have our Spelling Books at home from the Learning Packs we took home at the end of school. Choose 10 new words to begin learning! A supporting video will be posted on the Moa Hub Facebook page on Wednesday.

Collage of lockdown photos Create a collage of photos from your lockdown bubble and share them with us! Remember to get permission from others before you share online! <i>There are lots of free photo collage apps available to help with this! Please check with your parents before downloading!</i>	Create/design a new Ngakonui School sign Design and create a new sign for NVS - This could replace the green sign on the field by the courts. What features will your sign have? What will it be made from?
