NVS PTA – Grocery Grab 2021

Terms & Conditions

- a. **The grocery grab will be completed at a mutually agreeable date** and time at Taumarunui New World. **Subject to the sale of tickets and COVID restrictions.** At this stage it will be **Tuesday 5th October at 8pm** at the new Taumarunui Pop up site in Turaki Street.
- b. The Fundraiser will start **Monday 13th September 2021 and finishes on Friday 1st October at 12pm.**(Again dependent on sales)
- c. Winner will be announced publicly on **Friday 1st October 2021** through police draw and Facebook Post alive recording at our end of term assembly.
- d. **Named ticket holder must either push the trolley or pick the groceries** (or a nominated representative if required)
- e. **The trolley pusher** can only push the trolley, there is to be no grabbing by the trolley pusher
- f. **Items must be individually picked** and **CANNOT** be strong-armed
- g. **Start line will be at the front door** but may change based on store recommendations.
- h. **Limit of a maximum of 4** of any of the same sort of product
- i. **Each grocery grab has a cash limit-** once the cash limit has been achieved at the checkout all following items will be returned to the shelves.
- j. **Alcohol, lotto, gift baskets,** instant kiwi, tobacco, batteries and gift voucher products are excluded, regardless of the age of the winner
- k. **Extra trolleys will be placed at the end of the aisles** for the grabber and pusher to use as required, but not necessary
- l. **All entries, Spare Tickets and money are to be returned to NVS Office** no later than **Wednesday 29th September** There will be a final push to sell on our Facebook page leading up to the announcement.
- m. **All remaining Tickets that have been returned** will be available to purchase from our school office.
- n. **Video footage of the grocery grab** will be used for promotional material including social media, school website and school Facebook page so the winners must agree to this happening, or ensure those who are doing the grab are also happy with this.
- o. **In the event of a COVID-19 or an Alert Level change,** the draw will proceed but redeeming of prizes may be held at a later date if required due to Government Guidelines/ requirements.
- p. **Funds will be used** to support the school.
- q. **The grocery grab is open to all members** of NVS staff, board, PTA, school community and the wider community.
- r. **The grocery grab will have a limit of cost-** 1st place total of \$1500, 2nd place a total of \$800 and third place a maximum of \$750.

- s. **There will be 3 draws**- 2 minutes/ 1.5 minutes and 1 minute. We will also have a prize for 4th through to 7th place of \$50 grocery card and 8th through to 10th \$30 grocery card.
- t. There will be a **total of 2000 tickets at \$5.00 a ticket.**
- u. Each family will be asked to **sell a book of 10 tickets at least.**
- v. **If a ticket has not been paid for through internet banking or cash;** and the money is not produced by the closing date of the draw- 30 September 5pm; the ticket will be void. **And therefore will not be included in the raffle.**
- w. **Please note the prizes cannot be redeemed into cash.**
